GAMING ACT, 2014 (TRANSITIONAL PERIOD PROCEDURE) NOTICE, 2014

The Minister in exercise of the powers conferred by section 85 of the Gaming Act, 2014 makes the following notice—

WHEREAS pursuant to section 85(18) of the Gaming Act, 2014 ("the Act") all owners of businesses electing to continue the operation of such business during the transitional period shall cause a sworn affidavit to be served on the Secretary of the Gaming Board in the manner prescribed in the First Schedule to the Gaming House Operator Regulations, 2014—

AND WHEREAS pursuant to section 85(20) of the Act, all owners of businesses electing to cease the operation of such business during the transitional period shall cause a sworn affidavit to be served on the Secretary of the Gaming Board in the manner prescribed in the Second Schedule to the Gaming House Operator Regulations, 2014—

NOTICE IS HEREBY given that the aforementioned affidavits shall be served on or before 4:00 pm on the 8th day of December 2014 at---

WHEREAS pursuant to section 85(16) of the Act, pending the award of gaming house operator and gaming house premises licences, it shall be lawful for any establishment (which, at the effective date, had been carrying on the business which shall be authorised under sections 44, 45 and 46 of the Act), to continue the operation of such business for a period commencing on the effective date and ending on such date as the Minister may specify by notice in the Gazette for the closure of all such businesses in The Bahamas (hereinafter referred to as "the transitional period"); provided that the owner of such business shall—

"make full and frank disclosure, by the date and in accordance with the procedure to be determined by the Minister by notice in the Gazette or by service of a notice upon such owner, of all turnover and gross profits generated

by the conduct of such business, as defined in the Business Licence Act (No. 25 of 2010) in respect of a period of six years prior to the effective date, or such other period as the Minister shall specify by notice in the Gazette or may advise by service of a notice upon the owner of any such business (hereinafter referred to as the "review period")".

AND WHEREAS the procedure for making full and frank disclosure has been determined by the Minister as follows—

- (a) all owners of businesses who elect to continue the operation of such business during the transitional period shall make a full and frank disclosure statement in the format set out in Part A of the Schedule; and
- (b) the full and frank disclosure statement must be submitted under the cover of an Engagement Review Report, to be provided by an accountant registered with The Bahamas Institute of Chartered Accountants ("BICA"), in the format set out in Part B of the Schedule.
